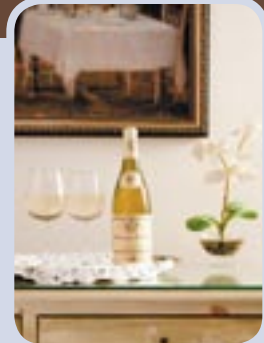

### 1807 House

The 1807 House is a sunny Georgian Colonial that was originally the home of Sea Captain Shubel Smith. Three rooms offer wood-burning fireplaces.

### The Grange

The Grange is an 8,000 square foot newly converted post and beam barn sitting atop the massive granite fieldstone foundation. Public areas include sitting areas, our restaurant, and the outdoor terrace with gardens, pond and waterfall. All Grange guest-rooms are air-conditioned, have gas fireplaces, widescreen TV/DVDs and two-person whirlpool tubs.
